

IN THE CLASSROOM



- In the classroom we will continue with most of our routines for learning

OUTSIDE PE AND PLAY

- PE gear cleaned
- Swimming pool open
- All students to have drink bottles
- Water fountains are closed
- No contact sports
- Students encouraged to use all available space and socially distance, 1 metre apart where possible

DROPOFFS AND PICKUPS



- All parents/caregivers entering the school grounds must scan in via QR code, school app or paper sign in
- Year 1 and 2 students collected from Harris Road and Ellerslie/Panmure Highway gates at 2.50pm
- Year 3-8 students will exit grounds at 3.00pm
- School gates are locked between 9.00am and 2.45pm



CLEANING & HYGIENE

Washing hands, using hand sanitiser and increased cleaning measures will continue. Classrooms are stocked with cleaning and sanitising supplies.
