# PRINCIPAL'S POST



Kia ora koutou. We were delighted to welcome all of our students back onsite last Monday after the week of Alert Level 3 and home learning. Thank you to all families who have supported us and followed our Alert Level 2 protocols last week.

At Alert Level 1 we will continue to follow all appropriate health measures at school including maintaining cleaning and disinfecting practices and encouraging good hygiene standards. We will also continue to expect people to stay home if they are unwell and to seek medical advice. It is fantastic that we can welcome parents/caregivers onsite before and after school but we ask that you proactively 'check in' via the COVID-19 QR code.

**School Attendance:** Regular attendance at school plays a crucial role in student wellbeing and achievement. It has been very pleasing since the last lockdown. We have had 95% + attendance at school last week. However we are still seeing a number of late students. Please ensure students are at school by 8.55am.

**Wellbeing:** As a school we will be focusing on Wellbeing/ Hauora in 2021 and we have three key initiatives and actions:

1. Enhanced students focus: healthy minds, healthy bodies, healthy relationships.

**Actions:** Embed mindfulness throughout the school, introduce JK Foundation (Mitey Programme) Term 2 onwards <a href="https://www.mitey.org.nz/">https://www.mitey.org.nz/</a>, kiwisport programmes and increased focus on physical activity and physical education.

2. Embed school values that are explicit and visible in school life (RESPECT, HONESTY, RESILIENCE, INTEGRITY).

**Actions:** Develop a common understanding of values across the community, explicit teaching of school values, values visible across the school environment and translated into other languages.

3. Building a sense of belonging, connectedness, relationships for our whole community.

**Actions:** Increased social gathering opportunities throughout the year, consultation with community, curriculum afternoons, language week celebrations, increasing home and school opportunities.


