
ANZAC DAY POPPIES

Room 8 had a fun afternoon with root vegetables in the māra kai last week. They had been reading The Enormous Turnip and Sione's Talo in class and we replicated these stories in the garden. Luckily we had a tiny turnip growing so we

imagined that it was enormous and everyone pulled together in a line to get it out of the ground.

We then planted a range of root vegetable seeds, including turnips, radishes, carrots and beetroot. We marveled at the different shapes and sizes of the seeds and that they hold the instructions necessary to grow kai.

We can't wait to watch these seeds grow and grow until they are big enough for us to harvest and eat.

- Plus fun competitions and activities for the students.


BOOK CHARACTER PARADE 2021
