PRINCIPAL'S POST



I regularly receive emails and phone calls praising the wonderful staff at Stanhope Road School. We are extremely lucky to have amazing staff across our whole school. Our staff are truly our greatest asset! Our teachers work incredibly hard to provide the best opportunities possible for our children. Our support and admin staff take care of

all the tasks that keep our school running.

From time to time we all make mistakes and these are never intentional. If you do ever have any concerns I ask that you address this promptly, through the correct channels and please do this in a respectful and polite manner at all times.

RESILIENCE: One of our four key values is resilience and this is crucial in the world we live in and sets children up for success. As parents there are a number of ways you can help build resilience at home. These include:

Model good coping skills – Teach by example. When your own emotions are high, say things like, "I can tell I'm getting frustrated. So, I'm going to take a deep breath (or pray, or take a little walk, etc.) before I try again." Or, "I'm sorry I got angry. I need to try again."

Praise effort, not just success – Children should understand that success is a product of hard work and sacrifice. But even when they try hard, sometimes they'll fail. Commend your children for trying, then encourage them to figure out what's going wrong and to try another approach or practice more. Celebrate small steps in the right direction.

Praise more than you correct – Do you find yourself constantly scolding? Make an effort to point out small daily victories. "You're ready on time. Nice job!" "Thank you for being so reverent during the prayer." Sincere praise helps children feel encouraged, understand more clearly what is expected, and be more willing to take on challenges.

Teach that mistakes and failure are part of life – Emphasise that your child's worth does not depend on success or winning. You will always love them. This will help your child feel comfortable discussing their mistakes and problems with you. As they grow to understand mistakes are temporary and are an opportunity to learn and grow.


