PRINCIPAL'S POST



The last two weeks have shown what a truly wonderful community we have at Stanhope Road School. We have all shown amazing resilience as we transitioned to Home Learning while in lockdown.

Thank you to the wonderful staff of SRS who are providing

excellent Home Learning programmes. The engagement of our students has been very high which is great. Thank you to all the parents/caregivers who have supported their children with Home Learning.

Term 3 and Term 4 School Calendar - Due to the lockdown and uncertainty of when we will return to school, there will now need to be a number of changes to our school calendar.

The APPA choir has now been cancelled in Term 4 and the Parent Group Fun Run has now been moved from 23 September to a date yet to be confirmed in Term 4. We will continue to update you on changes to the calendar.

We will continue to communicate with you when we have more information regarding possible timeframes for Alert Level 3.

A reminder at Alert Level 3, you legally must stay within your household bubble unless for essential personal movement including going to work and going to school. As the Prime Minister has regularly noted, schools are essentially closed at Alert Level 3 with the exception of those few children whose parents and carers must go to work at Alert Level 3, and there is no appropriate caregiver at home. Therefore, if at all possible, children should remain at home, in their family bubble during Level 3 i.e. if you are working or studying from home, you should keep your children at home with you.

New School BBQ – A huge thanks to the Warin and Gill Family who came forward to fully fund our new school BBQ. We really appreciate your support and look forward to putting this BBQ to fundraising use in the near future.



We hope that all our Tupuranga students and their families are safe and well.




PUĀWAITANGA HOME LEARNING
